

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO USE OF WATER FROM CHIPLEY WATERWORKS SYSTEM BY
THE COUNTY AND THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, FOR HIGHWAY PURPOSES
BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT

Be it ordained, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Chipley, Ga.
and it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same, that the Mayor
of the Town of Chipley, is hereby authorized and instructed to sign the
following agreement with the Board of County Commissioners of Harris
County, Ga.

"For and in consideration of the United States Government, through
the State Highway Department of Ga. and the County Commissioners of
Harris County, having delivered to the Town of Chipley, Nineteen
Thousand Feet of Waterworks Pipe, for the nominal charge of twelve
cents per foot, to cover cost of delivery, now the Town of Chipley,
through its constituted authorities does hereby agree to furnish to the
United States Government, for use of its Troops, Trucks, Tractors,
Tanks and other equipment passing through the Town of Chipley, on the
Military Highway, all of the water that may be needed for such use, in
the town of Chipley, without any charge whatever.
The Town of Chipley, through its constituted authorities, does further
agree to furnish to the County Commissioners of the County of Harris,
all of the water from said waterworks system, that may be needed in the
construction and maintenance of said Highway, where it is adjoining or
within reach of said water line, and to furnish said service of water,
without any charge whatever to said County Commissioners.
